All applicants should be motivated, self-directed, interested in working with other teens, and willing to take a leadership role at the Museum.

- One letter of recommendation from a teacher, advisor, or mentor

Applications are due **September 26, 2009**.

Selected applicants will be contacted by October 3, 2009, for an interview.
