Students spend time in the Museum's conservation studios, galleries, and classrooms, exploring the material characteristics of art and conducting laboratory-based experiments. They learn how Museum conservators preserve and care for the many different kinds of works in MoMA's collection—objects as diverse as oil paintings by Paul Cézanne, a Formula 1 Racing Car, and an iPod.
