ITALIAN AMBASSADOR, CONSUL GENERAL AND MINISTER
PLENIPOTENTIARY TO THE UNITED NATIONS TO ATTEND
OPENING OF ITALIAN 20TH-CENTURY ART EXHIBITION AT MUSEUM

The members' opening of the Italian 20th-Century Art Exhibition, the most comprehensive showing ever held of modern Italian painting, sculpture and graphic art, will take place on Tuesday evening, June 28, at the Museum of Modern art, 11 West 53 Street. Among those who will attend will be His Excellency the Italian Ambassador and Mrs. Albert Tarchiani; the Consul General of Italy Aldo M. Mazio; the Minister Plenipotentiary, Italian Observer to the United Nations Luciano Masci; and the Executive Secretary of the Exhibition in Italy Romeo Toninelli, who is coming from Italy especially for the opening.

The exhibition will open to the public on June 29 and will remain on view in the third floor galleries through September 11.
