Christmas cards by Matisse, Picasso and Ben Shahn are among the many now on sale at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, New York City. Mail orders are accepted.

The wide variety of cards include reproductions of such paintings as van Gogh's The Starry Night and Picasso's Three Musicians, drawings by Robert Osborne and Saul Steinberg, and photographs by Henri Cartier-Bresson, Bullaty and Morath. Prices range from 10 cents for a Paul Klee drawing, Serpent and Lady, to 50 cents for Leonard Baskin's Dried Grasses, engraved and printed by the artist on handmade Japanese paper.

Gift enclosure cards, imprinted with woodcuts by Antonio Frasconi or lithographs by Matisse, are 25 cents for a package of 10.

Members of the Museum are allowed a discount of 25 percent on orders of \$3.00 or more.
