Students will be admitted at a special rate of 75 cents to LYONEL FEININGER, CARICATURE AND FANTASY, an illustrated lecture by Dr. Ernst Scheyer at the Museum of Modern Art on Thursday, January 31, at 8:30 p.m. Tickets include admission to Museum galleries, open Thursday evenings until 9:00 p.m., where the exhibition The Intimate World of Lyonel Feininger is on view. Tickets are available in the Museum lobby, 11 West 53 Street, or by mail. Regular tickets are \$1.50 for Museum members, \$2.00 for non-members.

Dr. Scheyer, Professor of Art History at Wayne State University, was formerly associated with the Museums of Cologne and Breslau and with the Detroit Institute of Arts, Cranbrook Academy of Arts, and the University of Michigan. He is author of the forthcoming book, The Early Feininger. His lecture will be concerned with "the evolution of the figure in Feininger's work, showing in detail its emergence in his early graphic work, especially in caricatures for German, American and French humor magazines, and its later reappearance in his paintings."
