SUMMERGARDEN FEATURES CHRIS ROHMANN

Chris Rohmann, a young singer whose original songs gained a following in Birmingham folk cellars, London clubs and Vienna cabarets, will entertain visitors to The Museum of Modern Art's SUMMERGARDEN September 17 and 18 at 8 p.m. The programs, held in The Museum Sculpture Garden, 8 West 54 Street, will be free.

Rohmann, musical director and founder of New York's Free Theater, accompanies his original repertoire on a six and twelve string guitar. His songs range from folk-rock to love ballads, protest to comic songs.

On SUMMERGARDEN weekends the Sculpture Garden is open free to the public every Friday, Saturday and Sunday evening from 6 p.m. until 11 p.m. Light refreshments are available and the Friday and Saturday entertainment program is changed weekly. The programs are under the direction of Ed Bland and are made possible through a grant from the Mobil Foundation.
