SIXTH SUMMERGARDEN SEASON OPENS JUNE 4

A grant from MOBIL enables The Museum of Modern Art to open its world famous Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Sculpture Garden free to the public on weekend evenings as its sixth Summergarden season begins on Friday June 4, 1976.

Free admission is through the Sculpture Garden gate at 8 West 54 Street from 6 PM to 10 PM every Friday, Saturday and Sunday, June 4 through September 19. Short informal concerts are presented at 8 PM Fridays and Saturdays.

The season opens with KIRK NUROCK AND THE NATURAL SOUND WORKSHOP on June 4 and 5, and will continue with performances by other composers of experimental music; keyboard recitals of works by living American composers; country-blues, ragtime and jazz.

Last season's 60,000 visitors set an attendance record.
