Mr. Gundell started at Bloomingdale's as an Assistant Buyer and rose rapidly to

Department Manager, Buyer, and eventually Group Buyer within five years. He was promoted
to Divisional Merchandise Manager in 1984 at the Bloomingdale's Willow Grove, Pennsylvania

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store, and then became its Store Manager. In 1986, he returned to the buying organization in Manhattan, branching into new product categories, as a Divisional Merchandise Manager—first in Junior and Better Sportswear and then in Home Textiles. In 1991 he became General Manager of the Manhattan store. Mr. Gundell served in this position for three years during which time retail volume grew significantly and programs to enhance customer satisfaction were implemented. Having served successfully as Bloomingdale's General Manager, he was promoted to his current position.

Born and raised in Rye, New York, Mr. Gundell earned his B.A. in romance languages from the University of Pennsylvania. He resides in Manhattan.

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
