1. This is a wall by wall listing of the order in which the photographs were hung in the original exhibition at The Museum of Modern Art. Use this List in conjunction with Gallery Floor Plan and Installation Photographs for a complete record of exhibition.

The red number on the back of each photograph corresponds to the order on this List, which should be followed as closely as practical. The small a and b numbers (i.e. 3a) refer to hardboard pieces, so marked, of various sizes, which may be attached to backs of photographs to make them project from the wall. These projections have been removed for packing purposes, and while their use is optional, it is desirable, in that they add interest and emphasis to the installation.

3. Although one series of photographs often merges into the next, the exhibition progresses from sequence to sequence as indicated in the Roman numeral marked Headings.
