ART EDUCATION CONFERENCE TO EXPLORE THE PRESENT RELATIONSHIP OF ART AND THE PUBLIC

The annual Summer Conference of the Committee on Art Education sponsored by the Museum of Modern Art will be held this year on Sunday, July 17, at the Museum, 11 West 53 Street. Registration for the Conference will be held from 9:30 to 9:50 a.m. in the lobby. The fee will be 75¢ plus 15¢ federal tax.

Various aspects of the relations of art and the public will be explored. This topic has been chosen not only because of the growing interest in art on the part of the public, but also because of signs of reaction in the curtailing and regimentation of art programs. The panel members will present analyses of public reactions as observed informally through their respective professional activities. Speakers will include Abe Chanin, Docent, Museum of Modern Art; Emily Genauer, Art Editor and Critic, New York World Telegram; J. B. Neumann, Director, New Age Circle Gallery; Cipe Pineles, Art Director, Seventeen Magazine; Lydia Powel, Department of Education and Extension, Metropolitan Museum of Art; Lincoln Rothschild, Chairman, Art Department, Adelphi College, and George Wittenborn, book seller and Editor of Wittenborn and Schultz Art Books.

Films related to educational and art interests will be shown, and a student forum on the theme of the day will be held. The Conference will end with special discussion groups for the following topics: Magazines, Newspapers and Books; Museums and Art Galleries; Educational Films.
