AUSPICES

The exhibition is under the auspices of The Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, New York City in cooperation with the Westchester Workshop.

PLACE AND TIME

The exhibition will be held at the Westchester County Centre, White Plains, from Saturday, June 23 through Sunday, July 8, daily from 10 AM to 10 PM.

WHAT TO SUBMIT

Each art teacher, through the superintendents of schools is invited to submit four examples of the work of her students executed during the past school year. Paintings, watercolors and drawings are particularly desired although any flat medium is acceptable. Sculpture or handicraft will not be shown. Each work should represent a different child and wherever possible, children of different ages. We hope to exhibit work of the kindergarten children as well as that of grade school and high school students.

The drawings may be any size.

Each student should print clearly on the back of the work, his or her name, age, school, grade, and art teacher. If the work has a title, this should also be printed on the back. All works, thus submitted, will be placed on display.

WHERE TO DELIVER THE WORK

The work should be delivered to the office of Mrs. Chester G. Marsh, the Westchester Workshop, Westchester County Centre, White Plains, either in person or by mail on or before Tuesday, June 12.

No work will be accepted after June 12.

The Museum of Modern Art assumes no responsibility for works submitted.

RETURN OF WORKS

Works must be called for after the exhibition, from July 9 to July 14. Works will not be returned by mail.

PRIZE AWARDS

A jury, composed of Mr. Alfred H. Barr, Jr., Director of The Museum of Modern Art, Mrs. Helen Appleton Read, New York art critic, and Mr. William Zorach, sculptor, will award the following cash prizes and honorable mentions on Parents Day, Monday, June 25, at the Centre.

1st prize - \$25.00

2nd prize - \$10.00

3 prizes of \$ 5.00 each

10 honorable mention awards entitling the student to membership privileges in The Museum of Modern Art for one year.

Membership privileges of the museum are as follows:

Members receive invitations to previews of exhibitions. Members receive the Bulletin the first of each month from October to May.

They are admitted without charge on pay days and to lectures arranged by the Museum.

They are entitled to discounts on purchases of color reproductions of modern paintings.
