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MUSEUM OF MODERN ART DIRECTOR TO ATTEND EXHIBITION OPENING IN MADRID

René d'Harnoncourt, Director of the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, flies to Madrid today [July 11] to attend the opening, July 16, of THE NEW AMERICAN PAINTING exhibition at the Museo de Arte Contemporáneo. Organized by the Museum's International Program under the auspices of the International Council at the Museum of Modern Art, the exhibition of work by seventeen artists provides the first comprehensive showing sent abroad of advanced trends in contemporary American painting.

THE NEW AMERICAN PAINTING will remain on view in Madrid through August 15. Already shown in Basel and Milan, the exhibition will later travel to other European cities including Berlin, Brussels, Paris and London.

Porter A. McCray, Director of the International Program, will also attend the opening.
