G. David Thompson, Pittsburgh industrialist and internationally famous art collector, has been elected a trustee of the Museum of Modern Art, it was announced today by Henry Allen Moe, Chairman of the Board.

Mr. Thompson, who has served as a member of the Museum's Collections Committee for the past year, has given and lent many paintings to the Museum.

Mr. Thompson was born in Ohio and studied at Carnegie Institute. He was formerly Chairman of the Board of Pittsburgh Engineering and Machine Company and of the Fort Pitt Steel Casting. He has been president of Thompson and Taylor Company since 1933.
