Whale. 1937. Stabile; sheet steel, 6'6" high. Gift of artist.

IPICUSTEGUY, Jean

David and Goliath. 1959. Bronze, David is 47 7/8"; Goliath is in three parts, a) 30 3/8" high x 48 1/8" long x 28 1/4" wide; b) 19 1/8" high x 29" l. x 19 3/4" wide; c) 18 1/2" high x 23 1/2" l. x 17 1/2" wide. Matthew T. Mellon Foundation Fund.

SELEY, Jason

Masculine Presence. 1961. Welded chromium-lated steel automobile bumpers and grill, 86 7/8" high, 48" wide. Gift of Dr. and Mrs. Leonard Kornblee.

RODIN, Auguste

Monument to Balzac. Bronze, 9' 3" high. Presented in memory of Curt Valentin by his friends.
