MUSEUM OF MODERN ART NAMES TWO NEW TRUSTEES

Robert R. Barker of New Camaan, Connecticut, and Gifford Phillips of Los Angeles, have been elected Trustees of The Museum of Modern Art, David Rockefeller, Chairman of the Board, announced today.

Mr. Phillips has been a member of The International Council of The Museum of Modern Art since 1962 and Chairman of its Program Committee since 1965. He is a member of the Arts Council of the University of California at Los Angeles and of the Advisory Council of the Gallery of Modern Art, Washington, D.C. A nephew of the late Duncan Phillips of Washington, D.C., he is also a Trustee of the Phillips Collection.

Mr. Phillips lives in Los Angeles and is the publisher of <u>Frontier</u> magazine. He is also a member of the Smith College Finance Committee.
