CHARLIE CHAN AT THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

In the words of Charlie Chan, "Opportunity knocks on door again." The immortal philosophical detective from Honolulu and his most honorable family are back; this time at The Museum of Modern Art in a series of twenty-three films being screened from March 4 through March 17. Made between 1926 and 1942, the films selected by Gary Carey, Supervisor of the Museum's Film Study Center, include a host of unorthodox detective methods and a treasury of immortal lines ("She died because she knew too much").

With an aphorism for every occasion, Charlie Chan, who has sleuthed through movies, comic strips, books, magazine stories, and radio and television programs since 1925, is being presented at the Museum through the courtesy of Warner Bros.-Seven Arts.
