- 1937 Department of Education formed as pilot project -
Victor D'Amico became Director
- Exhibition program with New York City public schools
- 1942 Carnival created at The Museum of Modern Art
- National Committee on Art Education created -
now Institute for the Study of Art in Education
- 1944 War Veterans Art Center established - rented space - 681 Fifth Ave.
- 1947 How to Make Pottery and Ceramic Sculpture published
- 1948 War Veterans Art Center moved to 21 West 53 and became People's Art Center
- 1949 How to Make Modern Jewelry published
- 1950 First parent-children class organized
- 1951 How to Make Objects of Wood published
- 1952 "Through the Enchanted Gate" - TV series
- 1953 "Through the Enchanted Gate"- TV series
- 1954 Art for the Family published
- 1955 First annual summer classes established on Long Island
- Special study program inaugurated to explore problems in teaching art
and to circulate the findings to teachers and schools through reports,
publications and visual aids
- 1957 Carnival presented abroad - Italy and Spain
- Art of the Young Child published (2nd edition 1960, 3rd revised 1968)
- 1958 Carnival at Brussels World's Fair
- 1960 Experiments in Creative Art Teaching published (2nd edition 1963)
- 1962 Carnival sent to India and presented as gift
- 1964 Carnival in new gallery of Art Center, 4 West 54 Street
- 1969 Carnival in Harlem
