PAZANT BROTHERS LAUNCH MUSEUM OF MODERN ART "JAZZ IN THE GARDEN" CONCERT SERIES, THURSDAY, JULY 26, 8:30 P.M.

The Pazant Brothers, a seven-member Harlem-based group, whose jazz rock sound has been heard with such jazz greats as Lionel Hampton among others, will launch the "Jazz in the Garden" concert series at The Museum of Modern Art, on June 26 at 8:30 p.m. Appearing with the Pazants is soul vocalist Betty Barney.

The ten-concert series, traditionally featuring jazz, has turned five evenings over to rock this season, including Pacific Gas and Electric, August 7; Chicago Transit Authority, July 10; Muddy Waters Blues Band, July 24, and Orpheus, July 31.

Also scheduled to appear are the James Moody and Joe Newman Quintet, July 3; Jimmy McGriff and His Organ Trio, July 17; The Bob Patterson Gospel Singers, Isaac Douglas Gospel Singers, August 14; Kwame Nkrumah and his Ghanaian Drummers, August 21; and Robert Moog and the Moog Synthesizer, August 28.

Admission to each concert is 75 cents in addition to the regular Museum entrance fee, entitling ticket holders to enjoy all facilities including exhibitions and film showings until 10 p.m.
