EDITORS PLEASE NOTE: MOMA RESUMES SUMMERGARDEN ENTERTAINMENT

Starting August 13 and 14 entertainment will again be a feature of The Museum of Modern Art's free SUMMERGARDEN weekends. Singer-guitarist Jae Mason will entertain with jazz and folk music in The Museum's Sculpture Garden, 8 West 54 Street, starting both evenings at 8 p.m. Mr. Mason has been a featured entertainer at The Village Gate, Village Vanguard, The Gaslight, and was a part of the Woodstock program.

The SUMMERGARDEN evenings have drawn over 29,000 people to the Museum of Modern Art Sculpture Garden since the program's inception May 10 of this year. The program was originally planned to offer entertainment only on an occasional basis. However, a deluge of requests from the public has now prompted The Museum to resume its bookings on a regular weekly basis. The varied program, under the direction of Ed Bland, has included aerial dancers, an evening of Elizabethan and 20th-century Spanish songs, a Hindu dance performance and a folk-dixie group.

On SUMMERGARDEN weekends the Sculpture Garden is open free to the public every Friday, Saturday and Sunday evenings from 6p.m. until 11p.m. Light refreshments are available and the Friday and Saturday entertainment program is changed weekly. The SUMMERGARDEN program is made possible through a grant from the Mobil Foundation, Inc.
