In addition to Summergarden performances last season, Hellman's Angels have appeared at The Village Gate and Upstairs at the Downstairs, have released several record albums, and have been entertaining noon-hour crowds at Dag Hammarskjold Plaza on Wednesdays all summer, under the auspices of New York's Department of Cultural Affairs. Also under its auspices were appearances on the Central Park Mall, Staten Island Ferry and Channel 31's JAZZ ADVENTURES with Jack Tefoya. Hellman's Angels have long been involved in college workshop programs.
