## JAZZ GROUP HELLMAN'S ANGELS AT SUMMERGARDEN, AUGUST 16 AND 17

HELLMAN'S ANGELS, Daphne Hellman on harp, Lyn Christy on bass and Mike Gari on guitar, present an unusual approach to jazz, baroque and country music at 8 PM, Friday and Saturday, August 16 and 17, in the Sculpture Garden of The Museum of Modern Art. Free admission is through the Garden gate at 8 West 54 Street.

Daphne Hellman has led her group in concert throughout the world. Recent tours include Vietnam and Cambodia, the Orient, India, Africa, Europe and North America. In addition to Summergarden performances last season, Hellman's Angels have appeared at The Village Gate and Upstairs at the Downstairs, have released several record albums, and have been entertaining noon-hour crowds at Dag Hammarskjöld Plaza on Wednesdays all summer, under the auspices of New York's Department of Cultural Affairs. Also under its auspices were appearances on the Central Park Mall, Staten Island Ferry and Channel 31's JAZZ ADVENTURES with Jack Tefoya. Hellman's Angels have long been involved in college workshop programs.
