THE WALL STREET DIXIELAND BAND plays compositions of the 1920's and adaptations of Louis Armstrong compositions originally arranged for his "Hot 5" and "Hot 7" bands, in The Museum of Modern Art's Summergarden at 8 PM, Friday and Saturday, September 6 and 7. Free admission is through the Sculpture Garden gate at 8 West 54 Street.

The Wall Street Dixieland Band is composed of Joe Eggebeen on tuba, Glenn Kenreich on trombone, and Wes Norris on alto sax.

A grant from Mobil Oil Corporation enables The Museum of Modern Art to open its Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Sculpture Garden as a free public park from 6 PM to 11 PM every Friday, Saturday and Sunday through September 29.
