JULY SONGWRITERS SERIES OPENS AT THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

Songwriter MICHAEL COHEN opens Summergarden's July SONGWRITERS SERIES with performances at 8 PM. Friday and Saturday, July 4 and 5, in The Museum of Modern Art's Sculpture Garden. Free admission is through the gate at 8 West 54 Street.

COHEN is currently working on a second Folkways Records album to follow WHAT DID YOU EXPECT?! which was released last year.

He has performed at numerous area colleges and political rallies and has found a wide audience among WBAI Radio listeners: through his own shows, a Free Music Store concert and as a frequent guest of Bob Fass and Charles Pitts.

Cohen was born in New York and has played piano and guitar for most of his life. Among his musical influences he lists Chopin, Sinatra and Leonard Cohen.

Next week, July 11 and 12, Argentine songwriter and folklorist SUNI PAZ presents her own topical songs of Latin America, sung in Spanish and Portuguese.
