Free admission is through the Sculpture Garden gate at 8 West 54th Street. Peter Zummo's "Running on the Beach" (for cellos and trombone) will feature Mr. Zummo playing trombone. The works by Mr. Hayman and Mr. Morrow are both entitled "Wave Music" and are to be performed by forty unamplified cellos. Featured in Mr. Morrow's work will be cellist Simca Heled, with Paul Dunkel conducting.
