Jazz clarinetist PERRY ROBINSON and friends will present informal performances in The Museum of Modern Art's SUMMERGARDEN at 8 PM Friday and Saturday, June 16 and 17, 1978.

Free admission is through the Garden gate at 8 W. 54th Street.

Robinson is soon to release an INI album with Badal Roy and Na Na to add to previous disks on Savoy and Chiaroscuro.

Perry Robinson is the son of composer Earl Robinson and has toured with "Two Generations of Brubeck" and played in jazz festivals all over Europe. He has recorded with Dave Brubeck, Carla Bley, Archie Shepp, and Gunter Hampel, and in 1977 won Downbeat's "New Star Deserving Wider Recognition" award.
