Seven films by MARTIN RITT, director of the award winning NORMA RAE starring SALLY FIELD, will be shown at The Museum of Modern Art with Mr. Ritt introducing the screening of NORMA RAE at 6 PM on Friday January 11, 1980.

Four films will be shown on January 11: THE SPY WHO CAME IN FROM THE COLD (1965) starring RICHARD BURTON (112 min.) will be screened at 11:30 AM; THE MOLLY MAGUIRES (1970) starring SEAN CONNERY (123 min.) will be screened at 1:40 PM; THE FRONT (1978) starring WOODY ALLEN (94 min.) will be screened at 4 PM; and NORMA RAE (1979) starring SALLY FIELD (114 min.) will be screened at 6 PM with Mr. Ritt to introduce the film.
