Effective January 30, 1986, the cost of general admission to The Museum of Modern Art will be \$5.00 for adults and \$3.50 for students (previously \$4.50 for adults and \$3.00 for students). Admission for senior citizens will remain at \$2.00.

The Museum will continue its "pay what you wish" policy on Thursday evenings from 5:00 to 9:00 p.m. Admission is free to children under age sixteen accompanied by an adult and to Museum members.
