He describes the artistic developments that occurred in Vienna between 1898 and 1918, revealing how they are reflected in the paintings, decorative objects, graphic design, and architectural works on view. The tour offers visitors a concise and coherent interpretation of one of the most creative, complicated, and exciting periods in the history of modern art.
