The Museum of Modern Art presents a videotape and lecture in conjunction with the exhibition THE DRAWINGS OF ROY LICHTENSTEIN, on view from March 15 to June 2, 1987.

VIDEOTAPE

A short videotape, The Drawings of Roy Lichtenstein, has been created specially for the exhibition. Produced and directed by Edgar B. Howard for Checkerboard Foundation Inc. and The Museum of Modern Art, it includes interviews with Roy Lichtenstein and Bernice Rose, curator in the Department of Drawings and organizer of the exhibition. Beginning in April the tape will be shown on a continuous basis in the Edward John Noble Education Center.

Checkerboard Foundation Inc., founded in 1979 in New York City, serves as a nonprofit film and video production company dedicated to the American arts. It supports independent producers through a video grant program. To further its archival objectives, it documents living artists, scholars, and other individuals who have made important contributions to their respective fields.
