THE MUSEUM OF MODERN ART INSTALLS INFRARED LISTENING SYSTEM

The Museum of Modern Art has installed an infrared listening system to amplify sound in its Roy and Niuta Titus Theaters 1 and 2. This sound system eliminates all outside static, distortion, and interference to provide greater clarity for hard of hearing visitors and those who require additional volume for comfortable listening.

Lightweight, wireless headsets pick up sound signals through infrared light waves that are transmitted from the theater's master sound system. The system was made possible by a generous grant from the General Electric Foundation.

The headsets are available at the lobby information desk throughout the day for all film and lecture programs and are provided free of charge (a deposit is required).
