## HANDMADE PAPER

Prints and Unique Works June 28 through September 12, 1976 Art Lending Service Penthouse Exhibition Organized by Richard Marshall

Within recent years, an increasing number of artists have begun using handmade paper as an integral part of their works, not only as a surface on which to print or draw. Handmade paper offers a wide variety of surface texture, weight, and color suitable for various printing techniques, and has a malleability which allows the artist to form unique paper objects. The making of paper for specific work enables the artist to add to the cotton rag pulp other materials such as thread, fibers, wood, fabric, objects and dyes which enhance the textural and visual qualities of the paper. Included in the exhibition is paper made by artists in their studios and paper made at numerous paper mills in the United States, Europe, and India.
