The International Exhibition of Theatre Art, scheduled to open at The Museum of Modern Art on January 10, has been postponed to Tuesday, January 16, because of a delay in shipment of part of the foreign material. The exhibits from Soviet Russia, which comprise one of the largest and most interesting groups to be shown, are crossing the ocean now and are expected to arrive in time to be installed before the opening.

Owing to the size of the Theatre Art Exhibition, which will fill the four floors of the Museum, and the need for displaying the lighted stage models in special rooms, it will be necessary to close the Museum to the public from Monday, January 8, to Tuesday, January 16. There will be a gala preview and reception for members of the Museum and their invited guests Monday evening, January 15, from 10:30 P.M. to 1:00 A.M.

The Exhibition of Painting and Sculpture from Sixteen American Cities, which was to have closed January 1, has been extended to January 8.
