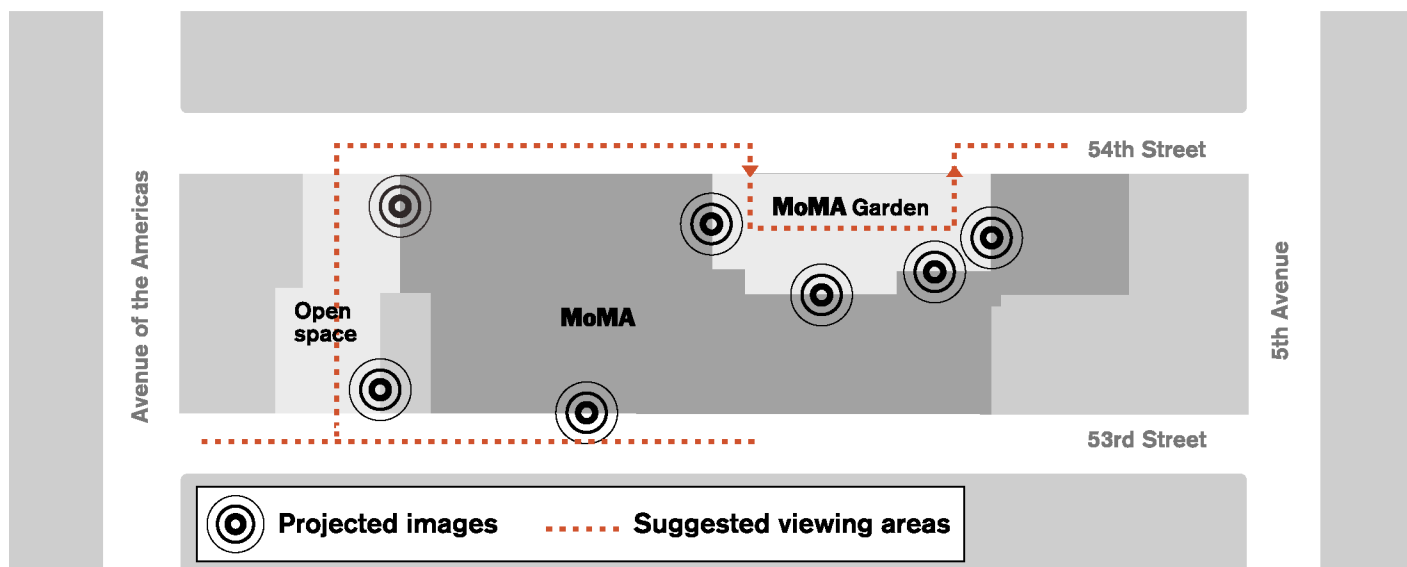

How to experience *Doug Aitken: sleepwalkers*

This is an outdoor exhibition on view every night from January 16 through February 12, 5:00–10:00 p.m.

Admission is free and tickets are not required.

The Museum galleries, main lobby, and restrooms are closed.

To hear commentaries on your cell phone, call (408) 794-0886, starting January 16.

Doug Aitken: sleepwalkers will be on view in all weather conditions. Please be sure to dress appropriately.

There is no seating and portable seating is not allowed.

Doug Aitken: sleepwalkers is fully accessible to wheelchairs and strollers.

Viewing areas are as follows: Fifty-third Street above the Museum entrance, the open space connecting Fifty-third and Fifty-fourth streets, and The Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Sculpture Garden.

Food, beverages, smoking and pets are not permitted in the Sculpture Garden.

MoMA staff will be on site to assist and answer questions during your visit.

Last entrance to the Sculpture Garden is at 9:45 p.m. and *Doug Aitken: sleepwalkers* ends at 10:00 p.m. sharp.

NOTE: Target Free Nights, which offers free admission every Friday from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. continues throughout *Doug Aitken: sleepwalkers*. However, there will be no access to the Sculpture Garden from the Museum building during this time. Visitors must exit the building to view the project.
