


Many artists and designers are inspired by the natural world. Try out these activities as you search for art that shows nature or seems inspired by it.

Zoom in! Make a drawing capturing the details of something from nature, like the veins of a leaf or the petals on a flower.



What does the sky above you look like? Draw it using the colors and shapes you see.

Collect objects from nature throughout your day. (Be careful not to cause harm, for example by removing flowers from the ground or leaves from trees.) Then create a display or gallery, use the objects to make art, or return them to nature.



Find something from nature, like a leaf or twig, and trace the outline or shape.

Make a rubbing. Place this paper over natural materials such as leaves or rocks, and rub over it with a crayon or pencil edge to create textures. Take photographs of something in nature from different points of view.
