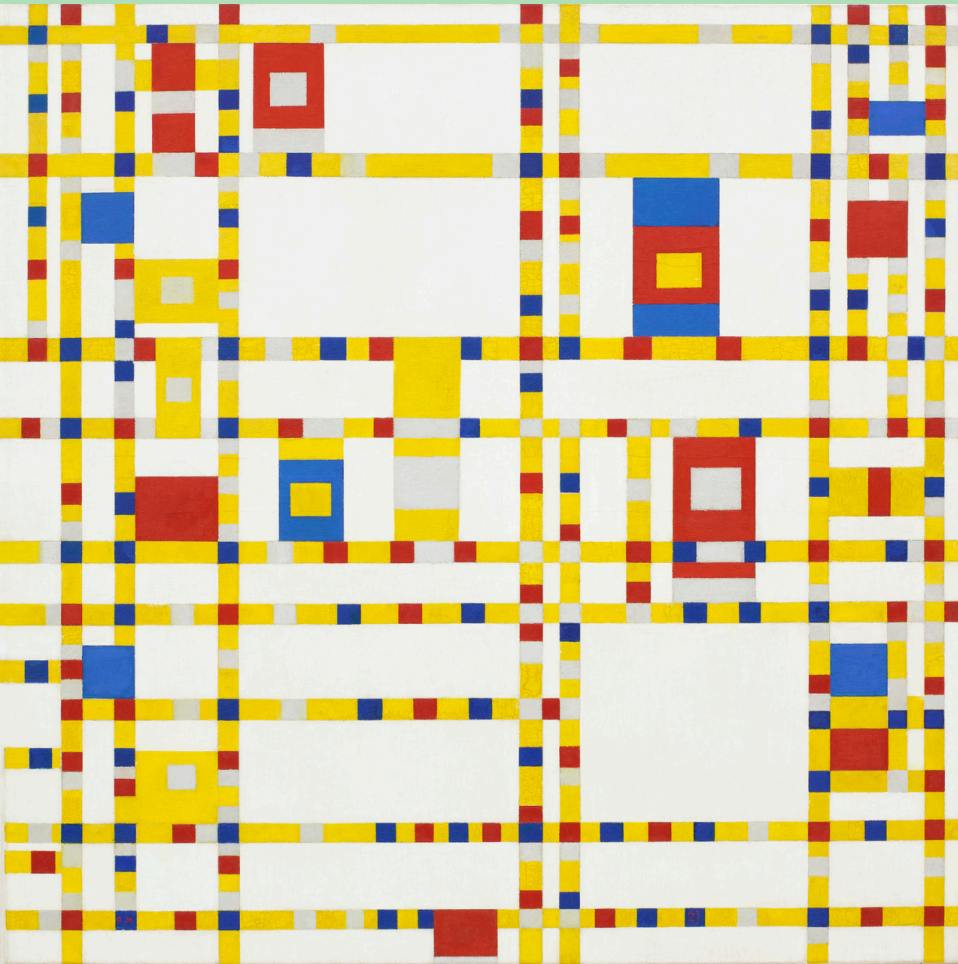


# Activity Card

**FIND** *Broadway Boogie Woogie*, by Piet Mondrian, in the Painting and Sculpture Galleries.

**PLAY!**



**LOOK** closely at the painting. What does it make you think of? Share your ideas with your friends or family.

**SCS**

Mondrian named this painting after Broadway, a long street that runs through New York City. The other part of the title, *Boogie Woogie*, is a type of jazz music that he loved. In the painting, Mondrian arranged the blocks of color to show the rhythm of boogie-woogie music.

**ASSIGN** a sound or city noise to each color. For example, "beep-beep" could stand for yellow. Then, pick a line in *Broadway Boogie Woogie* and play it.
