

Mr.Gubner of Rathbone called yesterday about the present reproduction policy which expires on May 25rd. He suggests that they write a new policy for \$10,000. (premium 24. per year) and that we report to them only if and when the total value of the reproductions exceeds this amount. This would eliminate constant correspondence adding and subtracting individual items which has been our practice over the past 13 years. At present the records that Rathbone has of reproductions now insured are most confused especially in regard to the early ones which were originally insured with another company. Under a new policy Rathbone would require that we keep an accurate record of the various individual items but that it would not be necessary to report them periodically to them.

Our records are now up-to-date and the attached list shows a complete coverage of all reproductions stored in C/E files or in Circulating Exhibitions. The total value of the reproductions is \$7247.25 and 158 frames are insured separately for \$830.
