I know how difficult this situation has been and how much of your time has been spent in bringing it to a conclusion, so I am especially appreciative.

I hope you will not let this matter influence your decision about showing one, or hopefully both, of the exhibitions which I of-fered you earlier this month. We would be delighted to have THE IN-THATE WORLD OF LYONEL FEDRINGER exhibition shown in Zagreb and I think it would be extremely interesting for your art public since it reveals an aspect of Feininger's work not well known in Europe. The DRAWDOS BY AREHILD GORRY exhibition is extremely beautiful and I thought it might be particularly appropriate for a Zagreb showing, since he is such a major figure in American art and his work has not been shown in Yugoslavia,

As I mentioned before, neither of these exhibitions involve an insurance fee or any other payments in dollars. Your principal expense for either show would be that of transportation from the preceding city on the itinerary.

I hope you will be able to let me have your decision about the Feininger and Gorky exhibitions very soon, and may I say again how much I hope you will be able to collaborate with us in presenting them to the Yugoslavian public.

Now, considering this situation as extremely disagreeable, I am going to propose to you another possible solution. Would you agree that we send you a painting by one of our contemporary artists?

I am begging you again, dear sir, to kindly consider the difficulties which have arisen in this connection, as well as our best intention to find, together, an appropriate solution.

I regret deeply being compelled to inform you that it is impossible for us to accept your offer concerning the loan of the exhibition "Abstract Watercolors" by 14 American artists, although this exhibition is very interesting from the point of view of the artists who are represented in it. The reasons for this are prosaic enough. Seeing that we never deal in foreign bills, we are consequently no longer in a position to participate in the costs of transportation. Moreover, we have not succeeded in resolving so far the problem of the enlargement of our gallery. So it is because of this that we are restricted in our efforts and, besides, all the dates are taken for individual exhibitions of our artists.

As you know from our collaboration so far, foreign bills constitute a special problem for us. It is because of this that so far a satisfactory solution to the problem of compensation for the Ben Shahn exhibition has not been found. I have addressed a letter to your Embassy in Yugoslavia begging them to issue an invoice to us, in order to permit us to turn over to them in Dinars the equivalent of the sum of 300 USA dollars, entrusting them with reimbursing to your Museum the costs that we owe you. I am sure that in this way the problem will soon be brought to an end.

I beg you to excuse my delay in replying to your letter dated May 17, addressed to Mme. Zdenka Munk, Director of the Museum of Arts and Crafts in Zagreb.

It was from Mme. Munk that I received two bills for 150. American Dollars: one for our Museum of which the name "Galerije Grada Zagreba" means in French "Galleries of the city of Zagreb", and the other for "Moderna Galerija" ("Gallery of Contemporary Arts") of Ljubljana.

I must tell you frankly that at present we find ourselves in an extremely difficult situation. Before the Museum of Arts and Crafts had received your offer on the subject of borrowing the BEN SHAHN exhibition, M. l'Arch. Zconimir Radic, who studied in America for one year, advised us to come to an agreement with you whereby the obligatory payment of a total percent of insurance would not apply to Yugoslavian museums, since these do not have foreign currency at their disposition. After having established that this understanding agreed completely with your offer, we didn't discuss this problem again. Now the question is how to fulfill the obligation. We would willingly do so; but the difficulty is that we can only make a bank deposit in dinars. In addition to that there would remain only one possibility; we could apply to the United States Ambassador at Belgrad, in order to deposit there the amount in dinars which would be paid to you in American Dollars by the Ambassador.

I await your proposal concerning the solution of the present problem.

However, according to the photos attached, I remember very well the work numbered BS-61-1, but No. 61.2954 has escaped my memory. Also, it is interesting that, all the works were placed in an absolutely irreproachable manner in the proper cases and the proper slots. Although it is difficult for me to discover the error now, I suppose it might be due to a wrong marking, either in your previous list of works or in the cases. Since on January 7, 1963 we gave the order to "Jugosped" of Ljubljana to send the entire shipment to Stockholm, I propose to draw the attention of the Moderna Museet of Stockholm to the possibility of resolving this problem.

I am sending you by the same post all the publicity material on the exhibition published here. I attach a list of the articles and their authors. The Zagreb showing of the exhibition was visited by 12,734 visitors.

I am sending you separately 25 copies of the catalog. The price of the catalog is 500 Dinars. But, instead of sending us the equivalent in dollars, we should prefer to receive in exchange several of your museum's publications.

Thank you for your kind letter of September 28. Our exhibition: BEN SHANN: CRAPHICS closed in Baden-Baden on September 20 and we have asked br. Dietrich Mahlow, Director of the Staatliche Kunsthalle there, to hold it in his museum pending shipping instructions from you. We have also asked him to communicate directly with Mrs. Munk in order to coordinate shipping arrangements. On September 13 we wrote to Mrs. Munk, asking her to notify Dr. Mahlow of the name and address of the shipping agent in Zagreb to whom the exhibition should be consigned. I hope this information has by now been sent Dr. Mahlow and that arrangements have been made to send the exhibition directly to your museum.

Since you have not been able to place the exhibition for an October showing in Yugoslavia, we should appreciate it very much if, when it arrives from Baden-Baden, you could hold it in Zagreb until it is needed for your showing in November.

I had delayed answering your previous letter in the hope that we would hear from Switzerland regarding our offer of the Shahn exhibition for showing in Basel or Zurich for the period December 10, 1962 to January 7, 1963. Since we have not yet had word from Switzerland, we are assuming that the exhibition cannot be placed for the time indicated and should therefore be happy to have you schedule it for the Modern Gallery in Belgrade, especially since the showing period available coincides with the Modern Gallery's open dates. Would you please be good enough to have the Director of the Modern Gallery confirm acceptance at the earliest possible moment, indicating the exact dates of his showing?

The exhibition is scheduled to open at the Nationalmuseum in Stockholm on February 15, 1963 and we shall ask Dr. Carl Nordenfalk, Director of the Stockholm museum to make shipping arrangements directly with the Director of the Modern Gallery in Belgrade, so that the exhibition can leave Yugoslavia early in January.

I am sending you enclosed a copy of a letter recently received from Mr. Bozo Bek, Director of the Galerija Crada Zagreba in Zagreb (translated from the original French into English), from which you will see that Mr. Bek is encountering some difficulty in making payment to us in dollars for the ensurance fees due us for the two Yugoslav showings of our exhibition: BEN SHAHN: Graphics.

This exhibition was shown in the Galerije Grada Zagreba November 6 - 30, 1962 and in the Moderna Galerije in Ljubljana December 10, 1962 - January 7, 1963. Our bill covers an insurance fee of \$150 for each showing, totalling \$300.

Would you be willing to have Mr. Bek make payment to the U. S. Embassy in Belgrade in dinars and then reimburse us in dollars? We have in the past made similar arrangements with other embassies in cases where the transfer of dollars was a problem. I hope you will find it possible to help us in this instance and that you will be willing to communicate with Mr. Bek to inform him of the procedures required. I should appreciate it very much.

I am sending you enclosed a copy of my letter of April 23 to Mrs. Zdenka Munk, Director of the Muzeum za Umdetnost i Obrt in Zagreb, who is also, I have been told, President of the Association of Museum Directors in Yugoslavia.
