



Thank you for your fax of February 28. Unfortunately, the Cornell work that we are searching for, **Untitled (For the Sylphide Lucile Grahn)**, c. 1940-42, is not the same work as the one owned by Mr. Menno Mejyes, San Fransisco. After conferring with Sara Nickles, who works for him, and with Pace-Wildenstein in Los Angeles, where the work is consigned, we determined that his is a work with a similar title, but quite different visually. Again, the work we are trying to locate is illustrated in the Kynaston McShine exhibition catalogue, <u>Joseph Cornell</u>, NY: MoMA, 1980, Ill. 91, and in the exhibition catalogue, <u>Joseph Cornell</u> and the Ballet, published by Castelli, Feigen, Corcoran, 1983, p.45, ill. 24. In both catalogues it is referred to as being owned by the estate at that time.
