



### Alana.

Thanks for your clarification. But, dear Alana, you can't ask a cabinet maker to fix your car. If you mean by a "structurally-based" work one which is essentially formalist (lines and colors) it rather historically goes against what us conceptual artists do. There should be a difference between "minimal" and "post-minimal" (otherwise why have the two terms?) and I think my work shows that difference well. I want to propose a work to you which is on paper and about structure. I think these are the two key points of the show, no? It is not framed because it gets wallpapered (from 1972, so no frame from guys like me.) But, I humbly submit, it would be a great addition to your show.

#### DETAILS:

>The size varies according to the wall, so it could be made quite large. For the size of walls your plan shows, I think it should be at least 10 to 14 feet long. But it could be somewhat less.

>The blow-ups of the three or four sections (see drawing) would each be about 3 feet square, based on above.

>The paper is white and the type black, and it would be a thin, natural paper. It would be destroyed after the show.

>I would prefer it to be in a room by itself, but if that is not possible it must be on a wall by itself, at least.

>Important for the installation, any installation, is to know where the public enters the room from. Could you send me that? Any decision about which room/wall would need that info.

>This could be produced quickly and installed in about a half day.

Let me know, it would be nice to work together again (it has been soooo long!)




