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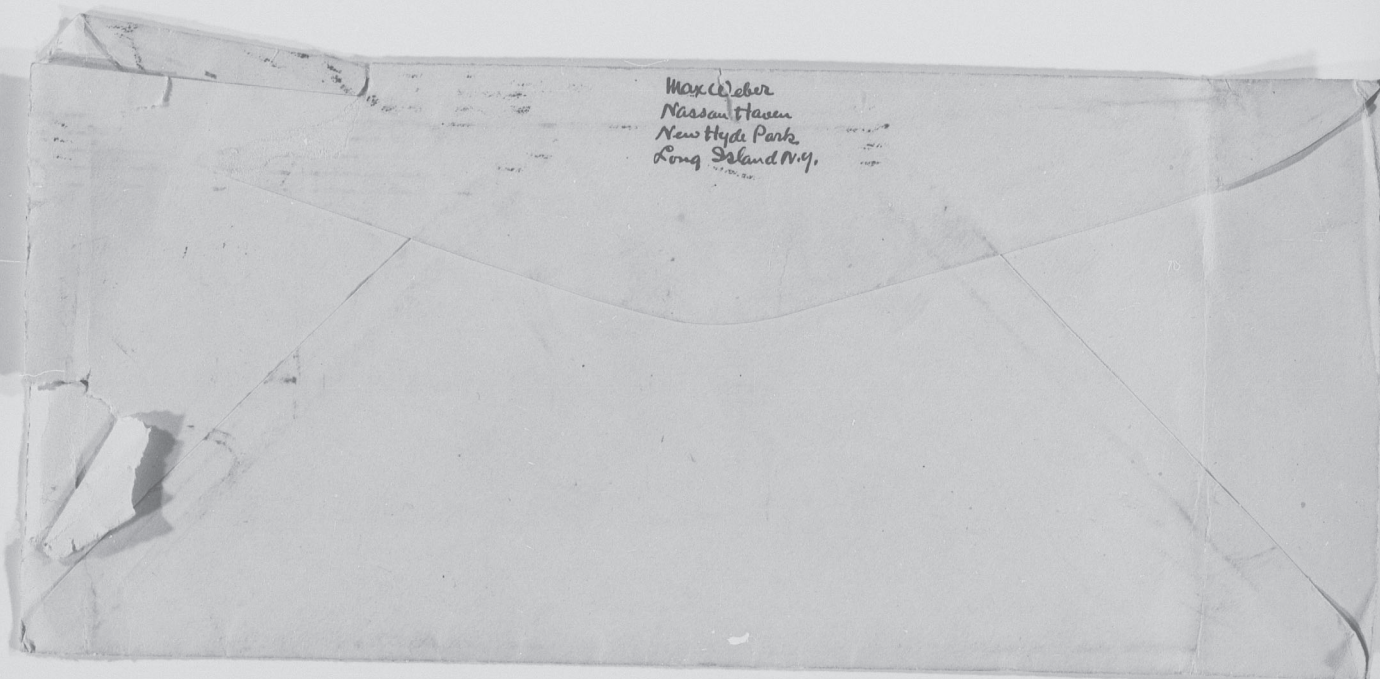

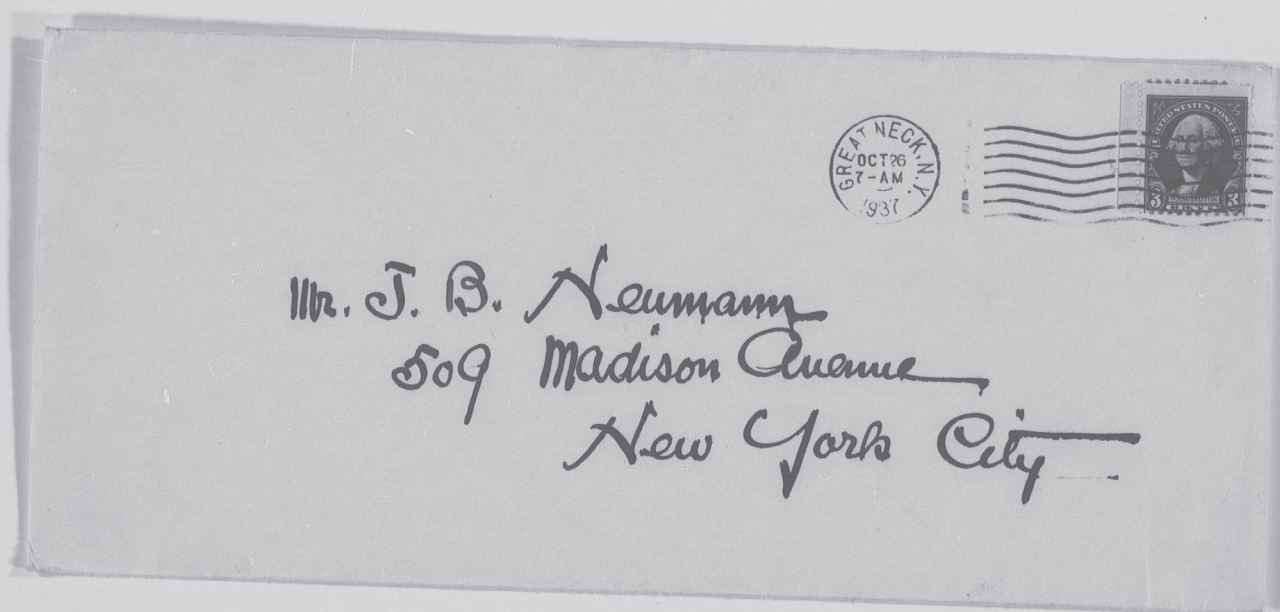
I am also enclosing the names and addresses of persons to whom I wish you would please send invitations.

With heartiest greetings and best wishes to you from myself and from Mrs. Weber whose appreciation

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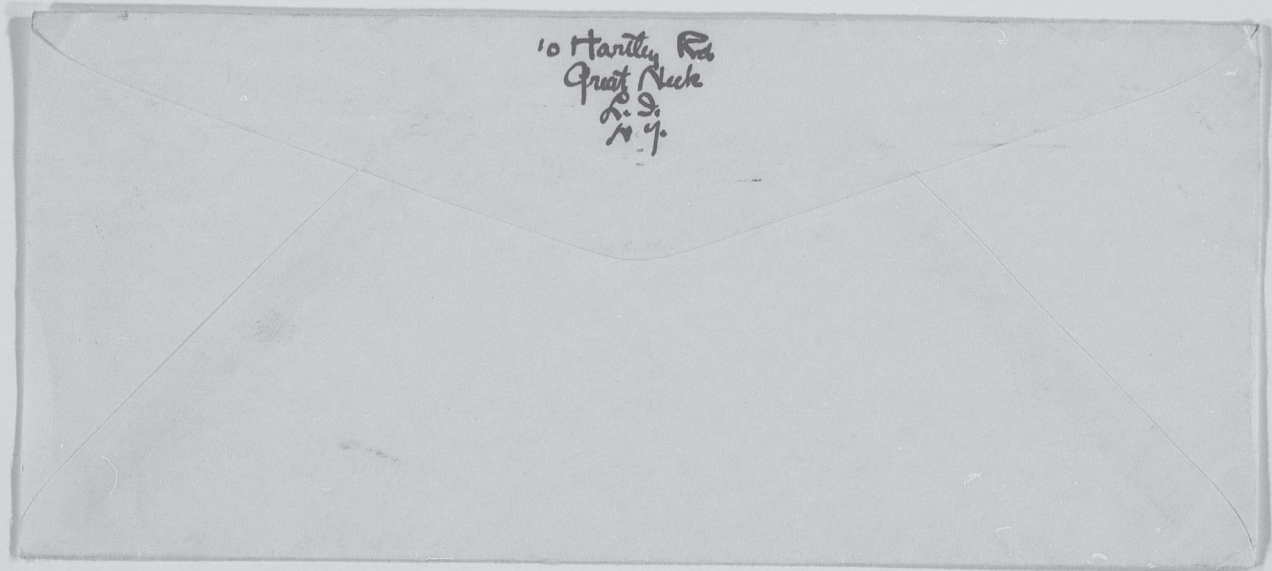
