ROMARE BEARDEN FACT SHEET

Romare Bearden has had important shows in major museums and galleries throughout the country and in Europe. On and off, over the years, he worked for The New York City Department of Social Services giving assistance to Gypsies. He became concerned with the unique plight of such a people living in the sophisticated environment of New York, learned their language (it has its roots in Sanskrit) and learned the lore of the different tribes. He finally wrote a handbook on Gypsies to aid the city agencies that deal with them.

Mr. Bearden was one of the founders of Spiral, an organization of black artists, formed to deal with the particular problems of black artists. He is the Art Director of The Harlem Cultural Council and has received a grant from the Guggenheim Foundation to write a book on the history of Afro-American art. Mr. Bearden is also a founder of Cinque Gallery. The gallery, housed in The Public Theater at 425 Lafayette Street, shows the work of young (22-30 yrs.) minority artists. Mr. Bearden and the other founders pay for the upkeep, newspaper ads, all the expenses - the young artists keep 100% of the proceeds from whatever they sell.

Romare Bearden has had a career as a song writer, too, and is still a member of A.S.C.A.P. One of his first studios was in the Apollo Theater building. He moved into what had been an old rehearsal hall and found a piano left behind. That was the beginning of "Sea Breeze", recorded by Billie Eckstein, and a raft of other published songs.

Mr. Bearden lives with his wife, Nanette, and their cat, in a wonderful studio down on Canal Street.
