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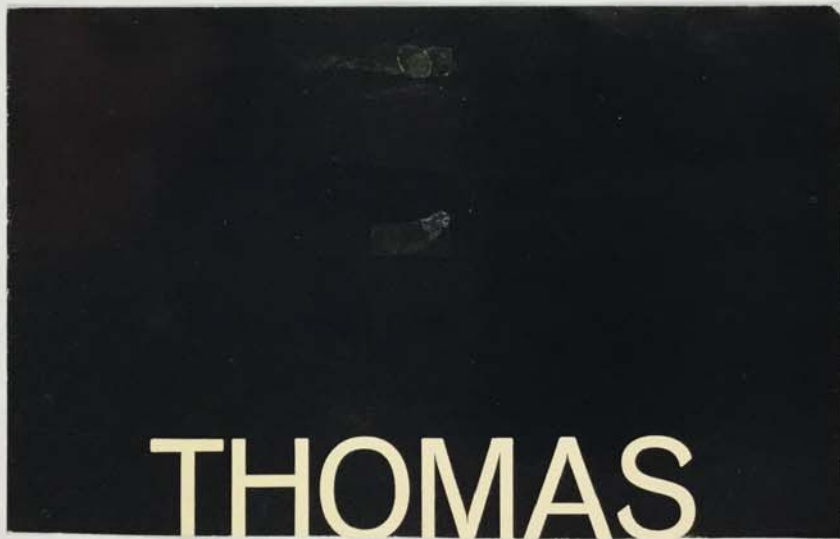

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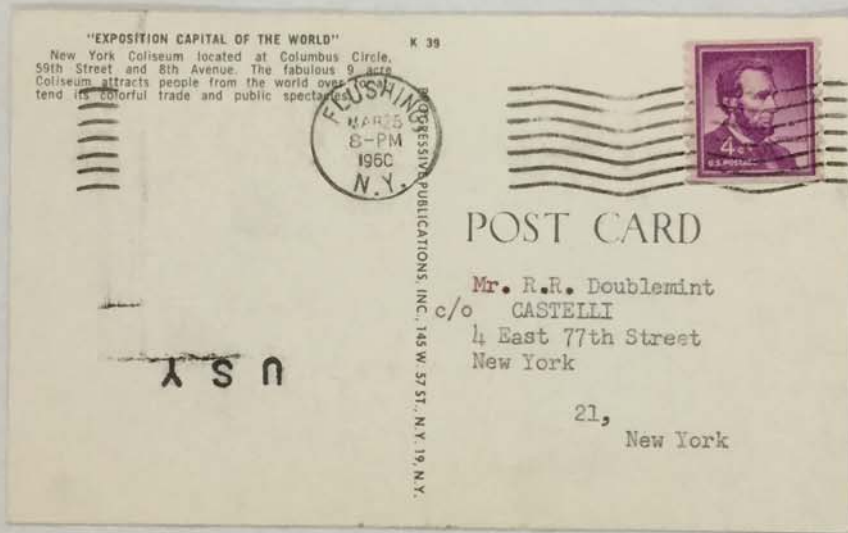

Here's a handy list of the many things your telephone can do to make your life easier, safer, and more pleasant. ■ You can hear the latest **weather report** for New York City and vicinity by dialing WE 6-1212. To get the correct time for New York City, southern Westchester and Nassau County, just dial ME 7-1212. For up-to-the-minute New York City **traffic and transportation** reports, call 999-1234. (Outside New York City, dial 212 999-1234). And coming late this year, you'll be able to dial a **Long Island weather report** including special maritime information. ■ In several localities, **poison-antidote** information is supplied 24 hours a day by a local Poison Control Center. In New York City, call WO 4-3800. Outside New York, check your directory under "Poison" to see if this service is available locally. If not, call New York City, adding the Area Code 212. ■ And **telephone service** itself is just a call away. If you're moving, want an additional extension or change in service, call your Business Office. They'll be happy to help you.

| ½ cup vinegar | 1½ tablespoons |
| ½ cup water | Worcestershire |
| ¼ cup chili sauce | 1½ teaspoons dry |
| ¾ cup ketchup | mustard |
| 3 tablespoons | 1 teaspoon salt |
| brown sugar | 1 clove garlic |
| | Dash black pepper |

Combine all ingredients. Simmer a few minutes to blend flavors. Makes 1½ cups sauce.



Quick and Easy FLOWER ARRANGEMENT FOR JUNE

"June is bustin' out all over" ... especially with roses ... and because so many people grow them and buy them, we thought you'd like to try this simple rose arrangement:

Cut medium-sized raw potato in half. Press cut side firmly to bottom of deep plate or any pretty bowl. Top of potato should be well below top of bowl. With sharp knife, remove thorns from lower stems. Length should be about 1½ times width of bowl. Cut stem to sharp point. Holding stem near base, insert about ½" from end of potato. If rose stem is weak, make small slit with knife in potato before inserting stem. Cut 2nd rose about 1" shorter and insert in front. Cut 3rd rose about 2" shorter and insert as shown. Fan out 4 roses as shown in diagram. Insert end rose in side of potato. Cut last rose short, and insert low, directly in line with ±1. Hide potato with rose foliage. Spread out leaves to cover top of container. Fill with water to cover potato. Add water to keep potato submerged.

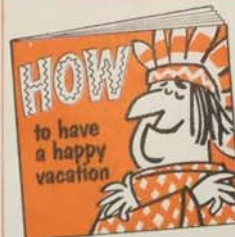
CALLING
