On the other hand, to be perfectly frank, I must tell you that we have been very disappointed with the contents. Of the thirty-two prints you sent us, two were small ones in black and white, which we could never sell at the price we are supposed to pay you; two are unsigned and, therefore, more difficult to handle; two are in poor condition, having, apparently, been exhibited under glass and suffered from light. And of the remaining twenty-six no less than twenty-three are "The Jiggler" which is, by far, the most difficult to sell, especially the version with the grey border of which you sent me fourteen.

My request for additional prints was, of course, based on the assumption that you would send me substantialy the same quality of prints as those purchased before.
