An illustrated lecture, ANCIENT ARTS OF THE ANDES, will be given at the Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, at 8:40 p.m., Wednesday, February 10, by Rene d'Harnoncourt, Director of the Museum and an authority on primitive art and its relation to the art of our time.

The lecture is being presented in connection with the exhibition, ANCIENT ARTS OF THE ANDES which, under Mr. d'Harnoncourt's direction, is currently on view at the Museum. After his talk, Mr. d'Harnoncourt will meet the audience in the galleries where the exhibition of ancient gold and silver jewelry, elaborate tapestries, stone sculpture and beautifully modeled ceramics is installed. The evening is being presented by the Museum's Junior Council, a group of young friends of the Museum.
