To accommodate the crowds coming to the Picasso exhibition at the Museum of Modern Art, the Museum will remain open Thursday evenings until 10 p.m. Supper will be served in the Garden Restaurant overlooking the Sculpture Court.

The Picasso: 75 Anniversary Exhibition includes more than 300 paintings, sculpture and drawings dating from the late 19th century to the present, lent by 95 public and private collections in Europe and America. It is the most comprehensive exhibition ever presented in this country of work by the most celebrated and controversial artist of our time.

Summer hours, therefore, at the Museum are 11 p.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays, 11 to 7 p.m. Saturdays, and 1 to 7 p.m. Sundays, and, specially arranged for the Picasso show, Thursday evenings until 10 p.m.
