To accommodate crowds at the Picasso exhibition at the Museum of Modern Art, the Museum will remain open Thursday evenings until 10 p.m. The Garden Restaurant overlooking the Sculpture Court will serve supper.

Weekday attendance at the Picasso: 75th Anniversary Exhibition is running about twice that of the Picasso show presented in 1939. During the first week the current show has been on view more than 24,000 people attended.

Additional free gallery talks have also been scheduled for the summer months. Mr. A. L. Chanin, Museum lecturer, will speak in the galleries every weekday afternoon at 3:30 p.m.

The exhibition includes more than 300 paintings, sculpture and drawings lent by 95 public and private collections here and abroad. It opened on Wednesday, May 22 and will remain on view through September 8.
