The Museum of Modern Art, 11 West 53 Street, today announced the appointment of Thomas Dabney Mabry, Jr., as Executive Secretary to fill the position from which Alan R. Blackburn, Jr., resigned in December 1934. Mr. Mabry will take up his duties immediately.

Mr. Mabry was born in Clarksville, Tenn., and was graduated from Harvard in 1925. He spent some years abroad in study, then came to New York where he was associated for two years with John Becker in his gallery. In 1931 he received a master's degree from Vanderbilt University. From 1932 to 1934 he held the position of Assistant to the President of Fisk University. Recently he has been Executive Secretary of the New School for Social Research in New York.
