Louis I. Kahn, architect, and Peter Blake, Managing Editor of "Architectural Forum," will discuss The Ideal City at the Museum of Modern Art tomorrow (Thursday, April 19) at 8:30 p.m. The program is the last of five public forums, The Building Boom: Architecture in Decline, presented by the Architectural League of New York and the Museum of Modern Art. Mr. Kahn will illustrate his talk with extemporaneous drawings on a large blackboard. Mr. Blake, moderator for the series, will include in his talk a summary of earlier sessions.

A limited number of tickets for the program, \$2.25 for Museum and League members, \$3.00 for non-members, will be available in the Museum lobby on the evening of the program. Tickets include admission to the Museum and galleries, open Thursday evenings until 10 p.m. Dinner and refreshments are available.

The series was organized by the Museum and the League to explore the effects on architecture of economics, politics and law.
