During the summer, the Museum of Modern Art will be open Thursday evenings until 10 p.m., with the afternoon film program repeated in the auditorium at 8. Fig Leaves, the opening program in the Howard Hawks film series, will be shown May 31 - June 4, daily at 3 and 5:30, and again at 8:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 31. The 1926 silent film features George O'Brien, Olive Borden, Andre De Beranger and Phyllis Haver.

On Thursday evening, June 7, the film will be A Girl in Every Port (1928, silent), with Victor McLaglen, Robert Armstrong and Louise Brooks; and June 14, The Criminal Code (1931), with Walter Huston, Phillips Holmes and Constance Cummings.

Jazz in the Garden, a series of ten concerts, will also be given at the Museum on Thursday evenings. The series begins June 21, at 8:30 p.m.
