In their first New York performance, the Max Roach Chorus and Orchestra with guest star Abbey Lincoln will give the eighth Jazz in the Garden concert at the Museum of Modern Art on Thursday, August 9, at 8:30 p.m.\* The group has performed together in Newport only.

Admission to the Museum is \$1.00; members free. The jazz concert is an additional 50 cents. In case of rain, the concert will be cancelled; tickets will be honored at the concert following. Other Museum activities continue as announced until the 10 p.m. closing. Dinner and refreshments are available in the Penthouse restaurant.

Jazz in the Garden is presented by the Museum in cooperation with the United Nations Jazz Society. Gary Keys, Herb Snitzer and Richard Jennings are in charge of programing and production. The series of Thursday evening promenade concerts will continue August 16 with Lambert, Hendricks, and Bavan\* and August 23 with George Russell.

The 1948 film, Red River, with John Wayne, Montgomery Clift, Joanne Dru, and Walter Brennan will be shown in the Museum auditorium at 8 p.m.
